

Golden keys for Fontenay concierge - Nina Bergmann receives the Clefs d'Or

Hamburg, 1st February 2024: Yesterday evening, special keys were presented at the "Zum Alten Lotsenhaus" restaurant in Hamburg-Övelgönne. At the "kick-off party" of the "Clefs d'Or" association of the Hamburg section, Fontenay concierge Nina Bergmann received the crossed golden keys on her lapel in a festive setting. The 37-year-old is now part of the renowned network of hotel concierges who share common interests, values and goals.

Furthermore, you must be nominated by two official advocates of the association and go through an application process. Les Clefs d'Or is an international network of hotel concierges who provide travellers around the world with exceptional experiences. However, the values also include promoting young talent, sharing ideas, networking and friendship. This is reflected in the international motto: "In Service through friendship".

Since November 2021, Nina Bergmann has been the beaming face and accomplished dialogue partner in front of and behind The Fontenay Concierge Desk under the direction of Head Concierge Jan Riepen. Prior to this, she held various positions at renowned hotels such as the "SIR Nikolai Hotel" in Hamburg or "Das Stue" and "The Ritz Carlton Hotel" in Berlin. Nina Bergmann experienced a formative period in 2012 and 2013 while working at "The Centara Grand Beach Resort & Villas" in Thailand. In May 2012, Nina Bergmann graduated as a "dipl. Hotelière, Restauratrice" from the SSTH Swiss School of Tourism and Hospitality in Switzerland.
